Street Sign Update

Some of you may be wondering what happened with the street signs we voted on replacing throughout the neighborhood. To sum it up in two words: Oakland County. They have rejected our permit request stating we cannot have the street sign and the stop sign on the same side of the street despite the numerous locations this style is used throughout the county. What does that mean for us? We can apply for a variance and see if they will make an exception, replace all the signs at double the cost due to twice as many poles being used, or consider another project with which to use the money collected. If the variance gets rejected we will most likely send out a notice for a special meeting to brainstorm ideas from the neighbors on how they would like the money to be used. Keep in mind our goal is to constantly maintain and improve our neighborhood.

Vandalism of KMMMA Signs
