We meet at 3447 Blasser at 7:00 pm. We meet on the 1st Wednesday of the month. These are our 2013 meeting dates:

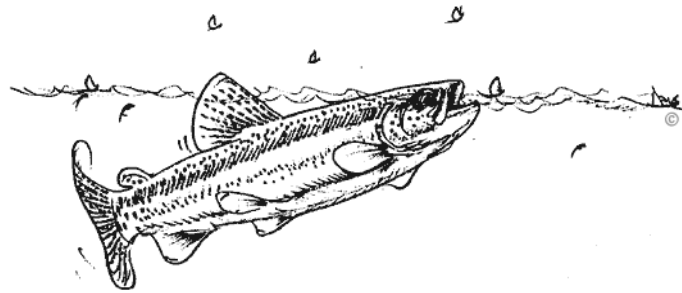

Spring Public Safety Reminders from Orion Township

- Proactive Reminders – As the warm weather moves in so follows an increase in property crimes. Especially crimes of opportunity such as thefts from unlocked vehicles and unsecured garages and homes. Please remind your family members, friends and neighbors to lock their vehicles and put all valuable items such as electronics out of plain view. Although some vehicles are forced open, the vast majority of vehicle thefts are crimes of opportunity where offenders are looking for vehicles and garages that are simply left unsecured!
- Seasonal Crimes of Opportunity – During the spring we see an increase in solicitors, peddlers and frauds. Most incidents involve non-registered unknown persons going door to door attempting to sell products or services. The most recent groups are going door to door attempting to sell meat. The good news is that many of your neighbors are calling our central dispatch center ([248 858-4911](tel:248-858-4911)) which has allowed us to identify and charge two different groups in the last three weeks. These “goods and services” are questionable and often leads to other types of crimes. We can expect these complaints to ramp up in the coming weeks with door to door sales of magazines, home improvement and various other scams. Avoid doing business with non-registered unknown people at your door. Orion Township requires all solicitors and peddlers (local ordinance #95) promoting goods or services to register with the township at the Clerk’s Office. All solicitors in Orion Township should be registered AND will be issued an ID permit to be carried on-person and is allowed from 11AM until one-half hour before sunset. Please call our non-emergency number at [#248 858-4911](tel:248-858-4911) to report non-registered solicitors. Help us protect your neighbor from becoming a victim.
- Latest local crime news – Recently, detectives identified and recovered property taken in area home invasions. In this investigation, detectives discovered that the crime victim’s homes had been targeted after an estate sale or when the family would be away for a family funeral. To combat this type crime, homeowners are urged to let a trusted neighbor know when you are away. Your best neighborhood watch system involves partnering with trusted friends and neighbors to keep an alert eye on anything out of place in your neighborhood. The key is to contact the police regarding any and all suspicious activity!
